Cookies and other tracking technologies can be used on our website and app in various ways. Therefore we feel it is important to explain to you what Cookies are and why they are used by dream-bid.com. Please read the following information thoroughly so you understand how dream-bid.com uses Cookies and what your options are.

With regard to the personal data that is collected, we always handle it in accordance with the dream-bid.com Privacy Policy. Capitalised terms are defined in the Terms and Conditions.

1. What are Cookies?

A Cookie is a small amount of data that is placed in the browser of your computer or on your mobile device. Cookies use several techniques to post data on or to read data from devices of users, such as from your computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone in order to e.g identify you or to store your preferences. The best known Cookies are small (text) files that are placed on devices and can be identified again at a later point. We also use other tracking techniques such as javascripts, web beacons (tags) (small blocks of code installed on a webpage, app or ad that can retrieve certain information about the device and browser you use) or device-fingerprinting, mobile identifiers and tracking URLs. All these technologies are together referred to as 'Cookies' in this Cookie Statement. At the end of this Cookie Statement, you can find a list of all the Cookies that we use and their purpose.

2. How long do dream-bid.com's Cookies remain active?

The Cookies that we use vary in life span. A 'session cookie' will expire when you close your browser while a 'persistent cookie' remains on your device for a certain period. See the table at the end of this Cookie Statement for the specific retention periods. You can delete all Cookies from your browser whenever you want via the Cookie settings in your browser. The whereabouts of these settings differ depending on the browser that you are using. To find out where yours are, use the search function on the settings page or use the help function in your browser.

3. Which Cookies does dream-bid.com use?

We use so-called First Party Cookies as well as Third Party Cookies. First Party Cookies are placed and read by dream-bid.com itself. Third Party Cookies are Cookies that are placed and/or read by third parties. We also use so-called Tracking Cookies. Our own First Party Tracking Cookies are solely used to track your browsing habits on our own Online Platform. Third Party Tracking Cookies can also be used to track your browsing habits across multiple (other) websites, not only on our Online Platform. We cannot control such tracking and therefore would like to refer you to the privacy policies of the third parties involved. In the table at the end of this Cookie Statement, you can see exactly which third parties place Third Party Cookies on dream-bid.com.

Functional Cookies.

Functional Cookies are Cookies that are necessary, in order to make the use of the Online Platform or certain features possible. There is, for instance, a Cookie that makes sure you stay signed in and do not have to continuously sign in when you click on a link on the Online Platform. These Cookies are placed independently of your consent when you visit the Online Platform or use relevant features. We also use Functional Cookies to:

- check what type of account you have
- detect if you are signed in
- store the type of device that was used to visit the Online Platform
- check whether the gallery view or the list view is used
- check if you are on the auction homepage or the collector's portal

Analytic and research Cookies. These Cookies capture how visitors use the Online Platform. We can use the information from these Cookies to analyse the use of the Online Platform and determine what causes errors on the Online Platform. Some of them are placed independently of your consent when you visit dream-bid.com, e.g. those that only collect aggregated data. Analytic and research Cookies are used to:

- track the number of users on the Online Platform
- track the time you spend on the Online Platform
- track the order in which you view different web pages
- decide which parts of the Online Platform need improvements
- show you feedback surveys
- understand what type of user you are

Preferences Cookies. We use these Cookies to know what you like and how you behave on the Online Platform. Based on this, we can show you lots in auction that match your interests the most. In order to show you personalised content on our Online Platform, we use these Cookies to track your behaviour so we get an idea about your interests and to store the ID of the auction you chose to see.

Commercial Cookies. These Cookies are used to show you advertisements on third party websites that match your interests based on your behaviour on our Online Platform, e.g. what lots you looked at. Furthermore, these Cookies are used to track which ads you have already seen to prevent you from seeing the same ads all the time, and to check whether an ad was clicked on.

Social Media Cookies. We want to offer our users the opportunity to share their experiences with our Online Platform and Service via social media. For this reason, we have placed a few social media buttons and options on our Online Platform. Through these buttons and options, the respective social media providers can place Cookies, that they can subsequently read. These Cookies allow:

- signed in users of selected social media platforms to share content directly from the Online Platform

- users to view embedded videos from our official youtube channel using Youtube's privacy-enhanced mode

4. How can you control the use of Cookies?

You can manage your Cookie settings in the browser you are using. Please follow the instructions provided by your browser on how to accept, remove or reject Cookies. Please know that our First Party Cookies play an important part of our Service. If you decide not to accept them, this could affect the availability and functionality of some of our features that make our Online Platform easy to use and attractive. For example, when turning these cookies off you may need to log-in on every visit. To manage Cookies from third parties, you can visit the websites <http://www.networkadvertising.org/> or <http://www.youronlinechoices.com/>. These websites enable you to block Cookies from specific third parties. If you choose to turn off certain Cookies you may still see online advertising, however, those advertisements will not be tailored to your interests or preferences.

5. May this Cookie Statement be amended?

We may amend or supplement this Cookie Statement. We strive to keep our Cookie information up-to-date but emphasise that Cookie overviews are always mere snapshots. Due to the constant innovation of the Online Platform, and the fact that the Internet and the various parties concerned are 2 continually changing, it is possible that up-to-date Cookies and Cookie information are not always available in this Cookie Statement.
